Ages: Kindergarten through 6th grade (Boys and Girls Leagues). The objective of the basketball program is to provide an opportunity for children to play basketball in an organized, competitive, yet recreational setting during the school year. Our emphasis will be on teaching the basic skills and fundamentals of basketball. Participants will also learn fair play, teamwork and sportsmanship. **Please be sure to indicate school and grade during the 2008-09 school year when filling out registration.** *Team and leagues will be formed by current grade level. Not all teams will be made up of children exclusively from the same school. Team assignment depends a great deal on who volunteers to coach and the school the child attends. One hour practice time will be determined by the coach. Practices will begin in late October. Games will be held on Saturdays, November 8 through December 20, with no games scheduled the week of the Thanksgiving holiday. Game shirts included in fee for 5th and 6th graders.
