

## SPRING YOUTH SPORTS LEAGUES

### SOCCER/FUTSAL

*Ages: Kindergarten through 6th grade (Boys and Girls Leagues).* The objective of the soccer/futsal program is to provide an opportunity for children to play indoor soccer/futsal in an organized, competitive, yet recreational setting during the school year.
